CONTEMPORARY DANCE CHECKLIST

Dance and ASL are both physical languages used to communicate

How the teaching strategies were used in this film: Interact with the dancer, not the interpreter Close the studio door Count using ASL Make sure the dancers can always see you Stand beside the interpreter Physically demonstrate instructions Face the dancers when speaking Learn basic ASL dance class language Turn the music up!

JAZZ DANCE CHECKLIST

Deaf and Hard of Hearing dancers use their whole bodies to capture the tempo.

How the teaching strategies were used in this film: Close the studio door Lay the speaker on the floor Include drumming Give time for the dancers to feel the beat through the floor Stand beside the interpreter Learn basic ASL Physicalize the beat Use mirrors Adjust to always be in the dancers' sightline

HIP HOP CHECKLIST Mixed class can be a positive experience for all

How the teaching strategies were used in this film: Send interpreters materials beforehand Lay the speaker on the floor Use V formation Give time for the dancers to feel the beat through the floor Stand beside the interpreter Deaf dancers can help non-deaf dancers Non-deaf dancers can help Deaf dancers Use mirrors Physicalize the beat
